Not to be outdone by the men, the Ladies also won their first inter-club match of the season beating Edzell Ladies, at Edzell, on 8th May.


This winning streak continued with the Junior Sixes Team winning their first match at Brechin Golf Club on Sunday 14th May. A fantastic achievment for
