Well done, Gents! A fantastic achievement!

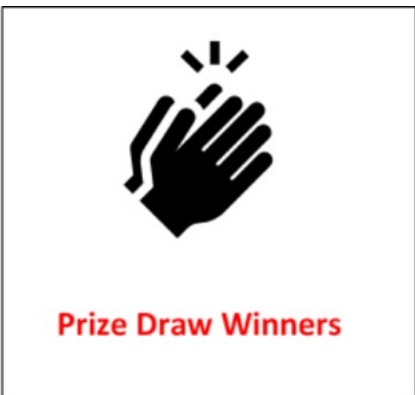
### Another Big Thank You!
