



MATCHPLAY COMPETITION RULES - SINGLES

Club Championship: Scratch competition, Matchplay - entry via two qualifying rounds, best 16 scratch players, seeded draw, White Tees, 1562 Course.

Club Championship Handicap: Handicap competition, Matchplay - entry via two qualifying rounds, best 16 nett players, seeded draw. Maximum 18 handicap, full difference of course handicap, White Tees, 1562 Course.

Miami Cup: Scratch competition, Matchplay - entry via one qualifying round, best 16 scratch players, seeded draw, White Tees, 1562 Course.

Lindsay Trophy: Handicap competition, Matchplay - entry via one qualifying round, best 16 nett players, seeded draw. Maximum 18 handicap, full difference of course handicap, White tees, 1562 Course.

Singles Scratch: Scratch competition, Matchplay - if tied after 18 holes sudden death to determine the winner. White Tees, 1562 Course

Footie Miller: Up to 12 course handicap at time of registration. Matchplay - (if your handicap increases during the competition you must play to a maximum of 12 handicap) Full Difference of course handicap, White Tees, 1562 Course.

Coronation Cup: 13 to 28 Handicap competition. Matchplay - Full difference of course handicap, White Tees, 1562 Course.

George Lloyd Trophy: Strokeplay competition. Best nett score over 18 holes. Maximum 18 handicap for competition, higher handicaps can enter but use 18 for the competition. If the match ends in a tie with the same nett scores, then determine the best nett inward half, then best inward 6, 3 and 1 if required with handicap adjustment. White Tees, 1562 Course.

Adelaide Trophy: Seniors aged 55+ at time of registration. Matchplay - Maximum 18 handicap, full difference of course handicap. White Tees, 1562 Course.

Handicap Cup: Maximum 18 handicap, Matchplay - full difference to be taken as holes up. (Max 13 up) If match is halved a complete round will have to be played. White Tees, 1562 Course

- Tom Valentine:** Seniors aged 55+ at time of registration. Matchplay - Maximum 18 handicap, full difference of course handicap. White Tees, Broomfield Course.
- The Cowie Tankard:** Seniors aged 55+ at time of registration. Matchplay - Full difference of course handicap. White Tees, Broomfield Course.
- Past Captains Jug:** A competition for all past captains of all previously merged clubs. Format of play to be decided by the immediate Past Captain.



MATCHPLAY COMPETITION RULES – PAIRS

- W.M. Stott:** Four Ball Better Ball, Matchplay - lowest player goes to scratch, others receive 9/10 difference of course handicap. Lowest nett score wins each hole. White Tees, 1562 Course.
- Mansewood:** Greensome, Matchplay - half combined course handicap difference. Maximum 18 handicap, all drive, each team to determine their best drive, 2nd shots at odd holes played by one player and the 2nd shot at the even holes to be played by the other player, alternate shots thereafter until holed out. White Tees, 1562 Course.
- F A Milne Trophy:** Foursomes, Matchplay - one player from each team tees off at the odd holes and the other player tees off at the even holes, alternate shots until holed out. Half combined handicap of course handicap then full difference. White Tees, 1562 Course.
- Silver Jubilee:** Greensome, Matchplay - half combined handicap of course handicap then full difference. All drive, each team to determine their best drive, alternate shots thereafter until holed out. Yellow Tees, 1562 Course.
- Broomfiel Trophy:** Mixed Foursomes, Matchplay - ladies drive at the odd holes and the gents drive off the even holes. Half combined handicap of course handicap then full difference. Strokes received according to the gents stroke index. White tees, Broomfield Course.
- Trefor Jones:** Mixed Foursomes (Alternate Drives) Matchplay - half combined handicaps then full difference. Lady drives at odd holes, strokes as per gent's scorecard. Men White Tees, Ladies Green Tees, 1562 Course.

Scratch Pairs:

Foursome, Matchplay - scratch event, max 10 course handicap at time of registration. Top players seeded with remainder by random draw, one player from each team tees off at the odd holes and the other player tees off at the even holes, alternate shots until holed out. White Tees, 1562 Course.

**IN THE EVENT OF A TIE AFTER 18 HOLES, THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURE MUST BE ADOPTED: -**

Scratch Competitions : Sudden Death.

Handicap Competitions : A match which ends all square should then be decided by the playing of a minimum of 3 extra holes if required, and thereafter sudden death. The play off should start where the match began.
Handicap strokes will be allowed as in the prescribed round.

Handicap Cup: If match halved, a complete round should be replayed or as mutually agreed by both players.

George Lloyd Trophy: If the match ends in a tie with the same nett scores, then determine the best inward half, then best inward 6, 3 and 1 if required with handicap adjustment.

ARRANGING TIES: -

All players will be considered responsible for ensuring that the tie is played by the date required.

IN THE EVENT OF A TIE NOT BEING PLAYED OR CONCEDED BY THE REQUIRED DATE, BOTH COMPETITORS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED, UNLESS IT CAN BE PROVEN THAT THE TIE WAS BEING PLAYED ON THE LAST PERMISSABLE DATE AND THE COURSE WAS CLOSED, THEN AN EXTENSION MAY BE GRANTED, OUTWITH THIS RULE OTHER EXTENSIONS PERIODS WILL ONLY BE GRANTED FOR EXCEPTIONAL CIRCUMSTANCES.

The effective date for these rules will be 1st April 2025, and the rules will remain constant for the duration of the competition.

Finals day is scheduled for Sunday 24th August and includes the following competitions:- Club Championship, Club Championship Handicap, Miami Cup, Lindsay Trophy, George Lloyd Trophy, Foote Miller, Coronation Cup, Adelaide Trophy and the Handicap Cup.
