Thanks also to Frances Milsom for topping the ladies up with gin liqueurs and more chocolate at the halfway point!

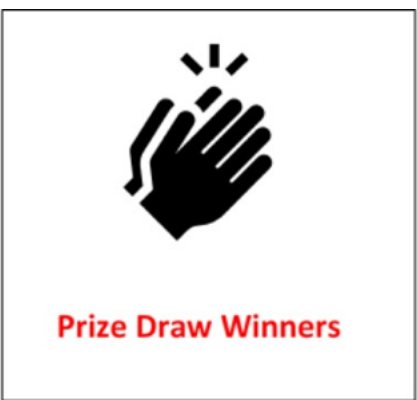
Coming in July
